



Homework Policy

Homework, or “Extended Learning”, can take many forms and include support for therapy programmes, work towards topics or Individual Education Programme targets. Work relating to behaviour programmes may also be introduced. The purpose of ‘homework’ should be clear and parents / carers understand the need for them to support the process. Teachers will monitor progress and provide on-going guidance as appropriate.

Homework is an important aspect of our home-school partnership, if parents feel the work set is not appropriate, they should contact the school. Where possible, pupils should be involved in setting, managing and monitoring homework. Homework should motivate pupils in their desire to achieve and become more skillful, knowledgeable and better prepared for the world outside school.
